It was a Los Angeles Republican woman by the name of **Mrs. Florence Collins Porter** who in 1923\* – soon after the ratification of the 19th Amendment granting women equal suffrage\*\* – organized the **Los Angeles Republican Study Club** which became a model for other Republican Women's clubs in other towns, eventually leading to the formation of the **California Federation of Republican Women**:

## ON THE BLACKBOARD

**SARAH'S COMING** - Sarah Palin's appearance guaranteed a sold-out crowd for the Reagan Library event. Her popularity was unaffected by her resignation as governor of Alaska. Contrary to Democratic Party hopes, she has not quit the public arena. She has strengthened her position among Republicans and others. She has activated SarahPac, a political action committee, which is dedicated to "supporting fresh ideas and candidates who share our vision for reform and innovation." HarperCollins will publish her memoir in spring 2010. Sarah calls it "a wonderful, refreshing chance for me to tell my story, unfiltered." Polls show people would vote 46% Obama and 42% Palin for president. Her vicious media attackers must be furious. Her enemies still file suits against her. Personally, I feel that Sarah Palin is a great role model, a real American woman.

**BUDGET WOES** - CA finally got a new budget. Cities, unions and School Districts are complaining bitterly about cuts. It's hard to sympathize with Los Angeles where the annual city payroll went up \$120 million last year. More than 6,000 workers earn over \$100,000. LAUSD's payroll shows huge salaries as well. Furloughs are temporary cuts. Parents and students suffer with the elimination of summer school and arts classes.

Our state lawmakers are the highest paid legislators in the U.S. at \$116,208 a year.

Next year we will face the same problems. Tough cuts have to be made.

**COLLEGE CRISES** - Most of the 180,000 UC employees face pay cuts and furloughs. Tuition may be raised by 20%, and

enrollment reduced by 40,000 students over the next two years. Student fees will be raised by 10%. Chancellor Reed states these measures can save 6,000 jobs and 22,000 classes. Drastic times call for drastic changes.

**POPULATION CHANGES** - Schools are greatly affected by shifts in population. A new study shows that the poorest 20% are twice as likely to leave CA as the richest 20%. They are driven by cheaper rent and home prices in other states, though CA home prices have dropped in the past year. States like Nevada, Texas and Washington have no income tax. At present, CA loses 1.5 households for every arriving household. If CA can start living within its means, maybe the golden aura will return to our beautiful state.

Additionally, the number of people caught crossing the U.S. border illegally has dropped for a third consecutive year. Government data shows 97% were caught on the southwest border, and 91% of those were Mexican.

**STATE TESTS** - Since the CA high school exit exam was introduced, graduation rates have plunged more than 30% among low-performing females and minority students.

It affected about 20,000 who would otherwise have graduated. LAUSD students were not included in the Stanford study. LAUSD claims a graduation rate of 67%. It does not take into account its large dropout rate. Some want to scrap the test but the State Supt. declared, "The exit exam plays an important role on our work to ensure that a high school diploma has meaning." The test deals with basic skills. We need educated citizens.

## SENATOR HUFF RESPONDS TO MULTI-BILLION DOLLAR BUDGET PATCH

**Sacramento** - Senator Bob Huff (R - Diamond Bar) released the following statement after the state Senate approved a complex legislative package of 31 bills aimed at closing the state's \$25.3 billion budget deficit:

"It was a long-night of debate, but in the end, lawmakers did what was necessary to solve the state's multi-billion dollar cash flow crisis without raising taxes," Senator Huff said. "Everyone is taking big hits, but this budget provides mechanisms in which to pay down the structural deficit and fully fund K-12 education. Furthermore, by allowing slant drilling into off-shore oil reserves, we will boost California's employment and revenues while decreasing dependence on foreign oil.

"The budget fix is not perfect, but it does institute a host of necessary government reforms, including the flawed IHSS and CalWORKS systems where there will now be greater account-

ability and less fraud," further commented Senator Huff. "By prioritizing funding to those who need it most and targeting those who ignore the rules we will save \$850 million over the next two budget years, and ultimately \$1.5 billion per year thereafter.

"Among other things, the last 18 months have demonstrated a real need for restructuring the way the state does business. The vote may be over, but California must continue the work this budget patch began. We must continue to bring our spending in line with revenue, and we must not lose momentum in fighting for basic reforms that stimulate our economy, create jobs, and ensure that every tax dollar is spent wisely. There is a lot still to do."

## BARACK OBAMA AND ALINSKY'S RULES FOR PSYCHOPATHS—PART 2

Obama and Hillary are lifelong followers of Alinsky. They use his tactics and ideology. That is why American politics became the politics of personal destruction when the Boomer Left came to power.

These claims require proof; but we have been looking straight at the evidence since the first Clinton term. Bill Clinton fits the diagnostic description of psychopathic personality, now relabeled "antisocial personality" in the DSM IV, the official diagnostic manual for psychiatry. Three out of the following [seven criteria](#) nails the diagnosis:

1. Failure to conform to social norms ...
2. Deceitfulness ...or conning others for personal profit or pleasure;
3. Impulsivity or failure to plan ahead;
4. Irritability and aggressiveness ... ;
5. Reckless disregard for safety of self or others;
6. Consistent irresponsibility ... ;
7. Lack of remorse, as indicated by being indifferent to or rationalizing having hurt, mistreated, or stolen from another.

I would give Mr. Clinton credit for Numbers 1, 2, 6, and 7, and possibly 3 (impulsivity) and 4 (irritability and aggressiveness).

Dick Morris, who advised the Clintons for 20 years, describes dramatic scenes that certainly fit the description. Or Bill's inability to stick with a meeting agenda, impulsively running endless bull sessions at the White House. As for 5, his picking up women opportunistically and in a way that put his career, not to mention his family life and American security, at risk. The Monica affair showed an impulsive, reckless president who got into power by endless lying and conning.

Liberal Democrats used to be normal Americans before the Boomer Left rose to power. Hubert Humphrey and Harry Truman had a strong sense of American morality. They despised the Stalinist Left and fought to keep them out of the Democrat Party. They were sensitive to ordinary shame and guilt, the emotions that make us civilized. When Bob Dole asked "*Where is the shame?*" in the 1996 presidential election, the answer came out: Not in the modern Democrat Party. People without guilt or shame make merciless power mongers.

Normal people slow down in School Zones where kids might run across the street -- not because they're afraid of getting a speeding ticket but because they can't stand the thought of hurting

kids. They don't need to cheat compulsively on wives and husbands to prove how irresistible they are. Normal people have internalized some modesty and humility, and are capable of respect and love for others. A common feature of psychopaths is the inability to feel authentic love and respect for others.

True psychopaths are often charming, seductive, and treacherous. They make natural con artists. Many psychopaths are extremely manipulative -- and what is more manipulative than stirring up hatred among victim groups to empower oneself? That is Jeremiah Wright, the diabolical Father Pfleger, James Meeks, and by his own definition of radicals, Saul Alinsky.

The worst are "malevolent psychopaths" -- people who sadistically hurt others. Hitler and Stalin, Kim Jong Il, Pol Pot, and probably many famous Western intellectuals fit the description of malevolent psychopaths. That is tragic and shocking. Historian Paul Johnson presents compelling evidence for malevolent psychopathy in the life of Jean-Paul Sartre, for example, and many others in his important book [Intellectuals](#). Western intellectuals have been the home team of Leftist radicalism for a century now.

But the single most important point about Alinsky's

"community organizing" strategy is that normal people can be trained to act like psychopaths: To become convinced that a "higher morality" allows them to act without conscience. As Alinsky [wrote admiringly](#) about V.I. Lenin, well known as a large-scale murder leader:

"Lenin was a pragmatist; ... he said that the Bolsheviks stood for getting power through the ballot box but would reconsider after they got the guns!"

That is a laugh line, believe it or not.

Alinsky called this "pragmatic radicalism." He differed from his Communist friends only in being more practical and less ideological. Alinsky was a radical because it suited his personality, because it was fun, brought him power and influence, and made him feel good. He was very clear in saying that, and he [inspired the Boomer Left](#) to follow his lead.

Alinsky [dedicated](#) *Rules for Radicals*:

"... to the very first radical . . . who rebelled against the establishment and did it so effectively that he at least won his own kingdom - Lucifer."

If that doesn't send a shiver down your back, you haven't been paying attention.
