One of the best ways to advance your club's funds is to have a

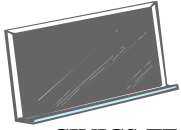

ON THE BLACKBOARD

CIVICS TEST— In the beginning, our forefathers devised a government of checks and balances. In less than one year, our new President has brought chaotic change to the system that served us well for over 200 years. The 2008 election transformed us into a one-party rule, with Democrats taking over the White House, the Senate and the House of Representatives. In effect, this made the Republicans unable to stop legislation. The so-called Stimulus Bill was steamrollered to passage with urgency "to create jobs and stop any recession." Industries and financial institutions got loans and government control along with them. The deficit and national debt grew into trillions almost overnight.

Then something happened to the American people. They started to wake up and protest, reviving the spirit of the Boston Tea Party. These ordinary citizens were labeled by the media as "right-wing extremists." They were ordinary citizens who had enough of raising taxes and rising unemployment. Some conservative, "Blue Dog" Democrats gained the courage to question other bills of change, like the Health Care Bill and Cap and Trade. HouH apap a

So our President devised a way for the Executive Branch to bypass Congress. He appointed Czars to oversee all parts of the economy, 30 so far. These appointees are neither vetted nor Congress-approved. They are answerable only to the President, who refuses to let Congress question them or their actions. The Czars are usurping the role of Congress, like a shadow government. The people chosen have been exposed by Fox and Talk Radio as radical thinkers. One of them, Van Jones, who believed the U.S. was behind the 9/11 attacks, was forced to resign.

BEYOND LEGISLATION: CYBER TERRORISM

Cyber security On Exhibit: Defending The U.S. Online. We're in the dark. That's the fear - and just part of the grim reality - if the nation's power grid were disabled by a cyber terrorist.

It was one of the messages communicated by a panel of officials - past and present - from the CIA, the National Security Agency, and the Department of Homeland Security among others, at the opening of a new exhibit on cyber security called "Weapons of Mass Disruption" at the International Spy Museum in Washington, D.C.

"Taking down the grid for months comes as close to a nuclear attack with many weapons on the United States as anything could," says R. James Woolsey, former director of the CIA. "You'd have mass starvation and death from thirst and all the rest."

So why is the U.S. at risk? Because so much of our infrastructure - including the electrical grid, water and sewage treatment, as well as our transportation system - is computerized.

This week, reports surfaced online about a phishing scheme by hackers that resulted in the posting of thousands of user names and passwords for Web-based e-mail accounts, including Windows Live Hotmail, Gmail and Yahoo Mail accounts. The disclosure underscored how individuals - not just governments - can be affected by hacking. Google and Microsoft said the incident did not involve a security breach of their systems.

Though he has called for a cyber security initiative, President

Now we are met with a test of our democracy, the Health Bill. The public option by any name would give the federal government unlimited control of our people. The President is using fear and promises to get the 60 votes he needs in the Senate. He is upset that Congress has not met his earlier deadlines. Why? It is because the people are expressing strong opposition with letters, faxes and again, tea parties.

Who will win this test? Sen. Snow and Sen. Lieberman have announced they will vote against the bill with any kind of public plan. Others, the Blue Dogs, are raising doubts.

The elections in New Jersey and Virginia will influence their votes if Republicans win the governor seats. Can we restore order; go back to checks and balances? It's up to us, you and me, to make a difference. Call, write or fax Congress today.

LAUSD CHAO—Los Angeles Mayor Villaraigosa, not content with running a large city, wanted to take over the schools. He spent valuable time and money over years and finally got to supervise some schools, choose personnel, etc. There has been no news of improvement. Supt. Cortines and the Board passed a plan to let private companies run some schools. This is a fundamental change, opposed by the teachers' union. Then there are the charter schools, gaining in popularity with mixed results. More alternatives include magnet schools, schools within a school and other ideas.

As I predicted, LAUSD rehired most of the 8,846 personnel who got layoff notices. Cortines wants to use Stimulus funds to balance the out-of-control budget. Chaos!

Obama has yet to name a national cyber security coordinator. In a May speech, he said: "From now on, our digital infrastructure - the networks and computers we depend on every day - will be treated as they should be: as a strategic national asset. Protecting this infrastructure will be a national security priority."

James Lewis, director of the technology and public policy program at the Center for Strategic and International Studies, says the U.S. is "really far behind." The first major hacking incident by a foreign power against the Department of Defense and other networks aimed at stealing high-tech secrets occurred in 1984, he says. "So, it's been 25 years and we're still waking up."

Lewis says the No. 1 problem revolves around espionage. The U.S. stands out as the biggest target and as a result, it's the victim of more cyber attacks than any other nation, he says.

There have been hundreds of "clandestine incursions" into computer systems where hackers, criminals or spies have disabled Web sites - including those of government agencies - and succeeded in stealing defense and intelligence data, according to the guide to the exhibit.

The museum's historian, Thomas Boghardt, says one of the most recent attacks, with the codename "Independence" occurred July 4. Suspected North Korean attacks targeted numerous Web

sites, including those of the Department of Defense, National Security Agency and the Nasdaq Stock Market.

"The cyber threat is the soft underbelly of the United States today in terms of strategic vulnerability," says former Director of National Intelligence Mike McConnell.

McConnell says he's concerned about terrorist groups with the capability to attack the U.S. money supply: "Because if someone is capable of destroying data - not stealing data, not hacking to deface the Web site, but successful in contaminating the accounting system, the reconciliation system - it could have impact of global proportions."

At the spy museum exhibit, the ceiling is designed to look like an electrical grid. Every few minutes the entire room goes dark. Then some words pop up on a flat-screen TV: "No Power.

No Communication. No Transportation." The list goes on.

It's easy to see that there are serious consequences of not having adequate protections in place. But the government faces a balancing act between safeguarding privacy and implementing cyber security protections.

"We have not found a way to square cyber security and civil liberties yet," says Lewis of the CSIS. "So, there are technologies that could make us safer, but we can't use them."

Philip Reiting, a deputy undersecretary at the Department of Homeland Security, says cyber security is a "shared responsibility" among governments, the private sector, the intelligence community and end-users. He says the government must move beyond its "whack-a-mole" approach - putting out one fire and then another and another - in favor of a strategy that "protects privacy by design." The head of the US Federal Communications Commission warned on Wednesday that there is not enough room in the airwaves for the "explosion" in wireless data traffic, setting the stage for a big realignment of spectrum usage as the government tries to help mobile carriers keep up with consumer demand. "The biggest threat to the future of mobile in America is the looming spectrum crisis," said Julius Genachowski, the Obama administration appointee who took over as head of the five-member FCC in late June.
