## OPERATION BOUNTY

The California Republican Party (CRP) and the Republican Party of Los Angeles County (RPLAC) are implementing a Republican voter registration program that will be administered largely through RPLAC. **YOUR CLUB MUST REGISTER** with RPLAC to be with Operation Bounty using a new registration form and agreement, available online through the RPLAC's voter registration page at [www.lagop.org](http://www.lagop.org). All bounty submissions must be electronic (as in the past) and in the format specified.

Any chartered organization of the CRP (your club, for example) that registers voters will receive \$4.00 per valid card. RPLAC will pay \$5.00 per valid card from the following Assembly Districts within L. A. County: 43,53,54,59, and 60.

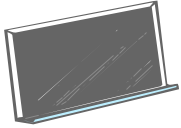
Valid voter registration cards which also have the permanent absentee voter (PAV) signup initialed (box #15) will get an additional \$1.00, as will the standalone PAV signup forms. Bounty payments will be made within 45 days. Faulty registrations will be deducted from future payments.

## ON THE BLACKBOARD - THE FIRST REAL WORLD WAR

We are at war. It is an undeclared war because Al Qaeda and other terrorists are not from one nation but from all over the world. They have been at war with us for decades but our leaders were in denial, even after deadly attacks on the USS Cole, the barracks in Lebanon and Saudi Arabia, the first World Trade Center bombing, the subways in London and Spain. The 9/11 attack woke up the U.S. "sleeping giant" for several years. We drove Al Qaeda from Afghanistan and overthrew the Taliban. We defeated Iraq's dictator who was welcoming Al Qaeda, but got weary of war and casualties. We resumed our routines and preoccupation with celebrities and sports.

The Muslim terrorists continue to plan our destruction. We "defeat" them in one place. They pop up in another. Today it's Yemen. They have tried to return to Afghanistan. Their aim is to conquer the world, convert everyone to Islam and rule by Sharia law. If they win, women and infidels who survive the bloodshed will be second-class citizens. Our leader's hopes of peace thru diplomacy with terrorist-backing nations have failed.

They are attacking us again. The FBI has foiled several plots by Muslim immigrants and U.S. Muslim converts to cause mass U.S. deaths: to bomb an Illinois federal courthouse, a Dallas skyscraper and a Marine Corps base in North Carolina. An Afghan immigrant shuttle driver, trained by al-Qaeda, was caught in N.Y. trying to use weapons of mass destruction, perhaps in the subway system. Four ex-convicts, who converted to Islam in prison, were ready to blow up N.Y. synagogues and shoot military planes with missiles.

Terrorist groups are being funded by criminal activities: staged accidents, holdups and charity frauds. The leader of a radical Sunni group in Dearborn was killed resisting arrest by the FBI for conspiracy to sell stolen goods and illegal possession and sale of firearms. In Detroit, FBI agents fatally shot the Imam of a Detroit mosque also resisting arrest on several charges, including selling stolen goods. The Imam was head of a national Sunni group that wants to create an Islamic state in the U.S. Five members of the Holy Land Foundation were sentenced to prison for funneling millions of dollars terrorists.

The Fort Hood Massacre and Christmas Day narrow escape alarmed us briefly, but now gossip and the economy are back on the front pages, not war news. Security is hampered by political correctness; no profiling and denial that our enemies want to destroy us and our way of life. The Jordanian doctor who killed seven CIA officers in Afghanistan revealed the worldwide connections of terrorist groups. His website called for jihad against Israel and the U.S., revenge for the Afghan and Iraqi wars, for Islam and the Palestinian cause. The Fort Hood doctor had ties to terrorists in Yemen and Pakistan.

Israel has endured 61 years of war against terrorists. We need to learn from Israel how to protect our citizens. We must be alert, like Israelis who report suspicious packages or actions to the proper authorities. Israel has survived and so will the U.S. with our help.

Did you know that the LACFRW Scholarships are funded by donations from the clubs? We hope you have built in an **LACFRW Scholarship** line item to your 2010 budgets. LACFRW needs to raise a minimum of \$1000 – preferably \$2000 - to fuel the LACFRW Scholarship program, which will ease some of the cost associated with college for one or more high school students. (FYI - The Executive Committee may increase the amount of the scholarship but reduce the number of students receiving.) With 35 clubs and growing, we can reach our goal to help deserving student(s). Don't forget, donations can come from individuals as well, so please ask your club members if they would like to contribute to the LACFRW Scholarship cause. There is nothing mandatory about this. All we ask is that you ask your board, and you ask your members. If someone wanted to donate \$1000.00 toward the Scholarship fund, we would name it in honor of a designated person. Someone may have a dear friend or loved one lost to them, and this would be a lovely way to commemorate them for 2010. Donations should be made in February, March and April. The deadline for the students'

applications is April 2, with the Awards Presentations taken place at the LACFRW May Board of Directors' meeting.

### CFRW SO. DIV. - CHARLOTTE MOUSEL SCHOLARSHIP

Further, now is the time for your Scholarship chair to advise local high schools – public and private – of the **Charlotte Mousel Scholarship**, sponsored by CFRW Southern Division.

Each Southern Division county (6 in all) submits the name of their County winner for final judging. This is a \$1,200 first place, \$800 second place scholarship from CFRW So. Div. going to the top two students. Last year, LACFRW's winner (a Walnut RWF submission) received \$500 from us, though he didn't win the Mousel scholarships.

All Club presidents have received the applications, guidelines and sample letters in recent CFRW Southern Division newsletters. The LACFRW deadline for

submissions is March 2. We will notify you of the name of the LACFRW Scholarship chair in the next newsletter.

CFRW So. Div. is also asking clubs to donate to fund this Scholarship. Donations in this case go to Martha McFarren, 12691 Woodland Lane, Garden Grove, CA 92840, made payable to CFRW So. Div./Charlotte Mousel Scholarship.



## CALIFORNIA'S BATTLE OVER MARRIAGE CONTINUES

California's constitutional amendment on marriage continues to be fought in the courts. Presently, *Perry vs. Schwarzenegger*, a federal lawsuit filed by two gay couples in California, is being heard in U.S. District Court in San Francisco. The case is being viewed as a sure stepping stone to the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals and ultimately, the U.S. Supreme Court.

Leading the opposition to Proposition 8, which was passed by a four percent margin in a contentious 2008 election, are constitutional lawyers David Boies and Ted Olson. The two were adversaries in the famous *Bush vs. Gore* battle in 2000. The two have joined forces to put gay life on trial in a federal court, challenging the outcomes of two state-wide California elections endorsing traditional marriage, and the California Supreme Court's final decision to uphold Proposition 8.

The U.S. Supreme Court also weighed in on the matter this week when federal judge Vaughn Walker quietly moved to allow the proceedings to be broadcast on the internet and in California federal courthouses. Attorneys for Protect Marriage

vehemently opposed the legal maneuver, claiming witnesses would face the same kind of retaliation and harassment as was experienced during the Prop 8 campaign. The U.S. Supreme Court sided with Protect Marriage and the cameras were ejected from the courtroom.

Legal experts claim that the jury trial in San Francisco has a predictable outcome, and that judge and jury seem set to side with the plaintiffs in the case. The two gay couples bringing the suit claim that their rights in marriage should be the same as heterosexual couples. The process seems destined to make its way through appeals courts and to ultimately be decided by the U.S. Supreme Court, perhaps as early as the end of 2011.

In the first days of the trial, Boies and Olson have put forth a case presenting testimony that domestic partnerships are stigmatized and that the City of San Francisco and others are losing millions in tax revenues every year that would be created by allowing gay marriages.

The trial is expected to last approximately four weeks.

## MY LETTER TO PRESIDENT OBAMA (On the State of the Union Address)

**RUSH:** I penned a message to Obama that I would like to deliver now. Because Mr. Obama, I think it's time we had a heart to heart talk. Let me be the father that you never had or never really knew, because I think you need some guidance. It's time to man up. It's time to grow up. That speech last night was an embarrassment. This is a nation built on individuality, built on liberty, free markets, and faith. Yet you, Barack, demand fidelity to a different belief system: A system that crushes individual initiative and free will. The president does not berate Supreme Court justices who are guests of the Congress and who have no ability to respond to your attacks. You've made such a mess of things, Barack, and it's time to stop deluding yourself. It's time to stop blaming others. You are delusional. You are delirious. It's time for you to assume the responsibilities of a president rather than pretending to be one.

You've driven the nation's debt over the edge. It is your responsibility to fix it now. Otherwise, our young people will have no future. You were wrong to grant terrorists constitutional rights. Even the libs in New York don't want the trial there

now! You, Mr. President, are endangering the security of this nation. Now fix it! Reverse course, and end the terrorists -- all of them -- back to Guantanamo Bay, where they belong. You are wrong to nationalize one industry after another from automobiles to banks. You are destroying competition and jobs. You need to stop what you were doing before million of more families go broke from your misguided policies. It's not too late to stop this. I know you're not going to stop it because last night you said you don't quit, and I know what you mean.

You're gonna keep plugging for the same agenda, which is going to destroy this country even more -- which makes me think, Barack, that's your objective. You know, Barack, unlike most presidents you're dealing with a Congress that has super majorities in both houses, fellow Democrats. 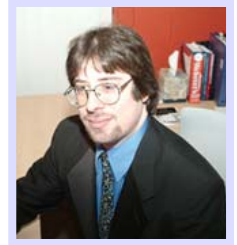
Are you The One that you've been waiting for? See, I have a

It was Barack Obama's inauguration day in January 2009 when I mysteriously received a curious email from The Black Tygrrrrr Express. With engaging and often amusing insight, Eric illustrates how people can disagree without impugning their humanity.

With *Ideological Bigotry* and his ongoing blog, Eric's ultimate goal is to make the world a better place. Within the pages, he illuminates that until liberals see conservatives as a noble opposition, they will continue to live in the intellectual, ethical, and political wilderness reserved for those who prefer rage, hatred, and anger to rolling up their sleeves and creating solutions.

Eric is one of the most humorous characters I have ever heard speak. His book is even funnier! I think most conservative readers will at first be shocked at his take on the issue of sex and finding girls of all political persuasions whom he finds fetching and would like to date. He names some high profile women who turn his head. Eric is a healthy red blooded bachelor!

Eric is a huge sports fan, especially football! He hosts Sunday football watching parties in his home in front of his flat screen TV. His blog alternates from political to sports. He has an amazing knowledge of all things sports.

little concern there may be a psychological issue at play here. I don't say this to demean you, Barack. I say it because I'm concerned. I mean, Tom Daschle was always "concerned" and I like the word. You have the longest enemies list of anybody I've ever known.

These people are not your enemies, though, Barack. They are Americans. They are part of this country. They are part of what makes the nation work. You are not. You have nothing to do, and have had nothing to do, with this nation's greatness. You can't lay claim to greatness on any scale, not even rhetorical. But you have no direct relationship to the greatness of this country. You are damaging the possibility of further greatness. Nevertheless, like a bully, you continue to threaten all of these people. The Supreme Court, Big Oil, Big Pharmaceutical, Big Retail, talk show hosts, Fox News, the list goes on. You threaten anybody
